Dear Ms. Ortiz:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 847213 (PPD Tracking# P008774-052820).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue.¹ Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold the submitted information under section 552.108(a)(1). However, as you acknowledge, you must release the basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.²

¹ We note the Plano Police Department (the "department") received a previous request for some of the same information from this requestor. In response to the previous request, the department indicates it released basic information to the requestor within five business days, and then withheld the remaining information at issue under section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code, pursuant to the previous determination this office issued to the department in Open Records Letter No. 2016-08690 (2016). Subsequently, the requestor made a second request for the same information on July 20, 2020.

² We note the requestor has a right of access to some of the information being released in this instance. *See* Gov't Code § 552.023(a) (governmental body may not deny access to person to whom information relates or person's agent on ground that information is considered confidential by privacy principles); Open Records Decision No. 481 at 4 (1987) (privacy theories not implicated when individuals request information concerning themselves). Thus, if the department receives another request for the same information from a different requestor, the department must again seek a decision from this office.
