Dear Mr. Ray:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 850723.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim sections 552.101 and 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code are applicable to the information you have marked on those grounds. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you must withhold the information you have marked pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 261.201 of the Family Code. We also conclude you may withhold the information you have marked under section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code.
