Dear Ms. Lazdowski:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 852551 (ORR# W010537-082820).

The Pflugerville Police Department (the "department") received a request for information related to a specified incident. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.130 of the Government Code.<sup>1</sup> We have considered the exception you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.130 of the Government Code provides information relating to a motor vehicle operator's or driver's license, motor vehicle title or registration, or personal identification document issued by an agency of this state or another state or country is excepted from public release. Gov't Code § 552.130(a). Upon review, we find the department must withhold the motor vehicle record information we have marked under section 552.130 of the Government Code. However, you have failed to demonstrate any of the remaining information at issue is subject to section 552.130. Thus, the department may not withhold any of the remaining information under section 552.130 of the Government Code. The department must release the remaining information.

<sup>1</sup> Although the department raises section 552.101 of the Government Code, it makes no arguments to support this exception. Therefore, we assume the department has withdrawn its claim this section applies to the submitted information. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
