The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 866484.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you must withhold Exhibit B-1 pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 261.201 of the Family Code. You claim Exhibit B-2 may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and Exhibit B-2, we conclude you may withhold Exhibit B-2 under section 552.108(a)(2). However, you must release the basic information from Exhibit B-2 pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code.
