The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 930230.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You state you have released some information, including basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code, a redacted crash report pursuant to section 550.065(c-1) of the Transportation Code, a DIC-24 Statutory Warning, and a DIC-25 Notice of Suspension, with redactions made to the DIC-24 and DIC-25 forms pursuant to section 552.130(c) of the Government Code and the previous determination issued in Open Records Letter No. 2015-26022 (2015).<sup>1</sup> You claim the information at issue may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold the information at issue under section 552.108(a)(1).

<sup>1</sup> Section 552.130(c) of the Government Code allows a governmental body to redact the information described in section 552.130(a) without the necessity of seeking a decision from the attorney general. Gov't Code § 552.130(c). If a governmental body redacts such information, it must notify the requestor in accordance with section 552.130(e). *See id.* § 552.130(d), (e). Open Records Letter No. 2015-26022 authorizes you to withhold public citizens' dates of birth under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy without requesting a ruling from this office.
