Re: Request for nine categories of information regarding the US 181 Harbor Bridge Project

Dear Mr. Jimison:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 926775 (Ref. No. 1287).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You state you have released some information. You claim, in part, the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.104 and section 552.107 of the Government Code.¹ Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold the information you marked under section 552.104 of the Government Code and the remaining submitted information under section 552.107 of the Government Code.²

¹ You inform us you sent the requestor an estimate of charges pursuant to section 552.2615 of the Government Code. *See* Gov't Code § 552.2615. The estimate of charges required the requestor to provide a deposit for payment of anticipated costs under section 552.263 of the Government Code. *See id.* § 552.263(a). You state the required deposit was received on October 21, 2021. *See id.* § 552.263(e) (if governmental body requires deposit or bond for anticipated costs pursuant to section 552.263, request for information is considered to have been received on date governmental body receives bond or deposit).

² As our ruling is dispositive, we need not address your remaining arguments against disclosure of this information.
