The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 932128 (ORR# D038230).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You indicate you will withhold some information pursuant to section 552.136(c) of the Government Code.¹ You claim the information you marked under section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to that section. Upon review of your arguments and the information, we conclude you may withhold the information you marked under section 552.108(a)(1). You must release the remaining information.²

¹ Section 552.136 of the Government Code permits a governmental body to withhold the information described in section 552.136(b) without the necessity of seeking a decision from this office. *See* Gov't Code § 552.136(c). If a governmental body redacts such information, it must notify the requestor in accordance with section 552.136(e). *See id.* § 552.136(d), (e).

² Because the requestor has a special right of access to the information being released, you must again seek a decision from this office if you receive a request for the same information from another requestor. *See* Fam. Code § 261.201(k).
