The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 932030.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. The requestor in this case knows the identity of the victim in the report at issue. To protect the privacy of the individual to whom the information at issue relates, you must withhold the submitted information in its entirety under section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy.<sup>1</sup>
