Dear Ms. Herrera:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 933310 (File No. 21093.4).

Texas State University (the "university") received a request for football game contracts with non-conference opponents during a certain date range. Although you take no position as to the disclosure of the submitted information, you state the university notified Jackson State University, Texas A&M University, the United States Military Academy, and the University of North Texas of the request for information and of their right to submit arguments to this office as to why the submitted information should not be released. *See* Gov't Code § 552.304 (interested party may submit comments stating why information should or should not be released). We have reviewed the submitted information.

As of the date of this letter, we have not received any comments from the notified third parties explaining why any portion of the submitted information should not be released to the requestor. As no exceptions to disclosure have been raised, the university must release the submitted information.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor. For more information concerning those rights and
