Dear Mr. Sylvia:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 940777.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. We note that you have only submitted information pertaining to the specified utility. To the extent any additional information existed on the date you received this request we assume you have released it. If you have not released any such information, you must do so at this time. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301(a), .302; *see also* Open Records Decision No. 664 (2000) (if governmental body concludes that no exceptions apply to requested information, it must release information as soon as possible). You claim the submitted information must be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.1331 of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you must withhold the submitted information under section 552.1331 of the Government Code.
