Re: Request for all reports called in by the requestor regarding her daughter.

Dear Mr. Sylvia:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 945403.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You have released basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code and claim the information in Exhibit C may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code. Upon review, we conclude you may withhold Exhibit C under section 552.108(a)(1). In Exhibit D, you must withhold the information you have marked under section 552.130 of the Government Code and the dates of birth pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at \*3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.). The remaining information must be released.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> The requestor has a right of access to the information being released pursuant to section 552.023 of the Government Code, section 261.201(k) of the Family Code, and section 58.008(d) of the Family Code. *See* Gov't Code § 552.023 (governmental body may not deny access to person to whom information relates or person's agent on ground that information is considered confidential by privacy principles); *See* Fam. Code §§ 261.201(k), 58.008(d); *but see id.* §§ 261.201(1)(2), 58.008(e)(2). If you receive another request for this information from a different requestor, you must again seek a ruling from this office. *See* Gov't Code §§ 552.301, .302; Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001).
