Dear Ms. Vinson:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 949668.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. We understand you have released some information and will withhold some of the requested information in accordance with the previous determination issued in Open Records Letter No. 2022-13609 (2022). *See* Open Records Decision No. 673 (2001) (so long as law, facts, and circumstances on which prior ruling was based have not changed, first type of previous determination exists where requested information is precisely same information as was addressed in prior attorney general ruling, ruling is addressed to same governmental body, and ruling concludes that information is or is not excepted from disclosure). You claim the remaining submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.107 of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold the remaining information at issue under section 552.107.<sup>1</sup>
