The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 949927.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. We have also received and considered comments submitted by the requestor. *See* Gov't Code § 552.304 (providing that interested party may submit written comments regarding why information should or should not be released). You state you have released some information to the requestor. You claim the information you marked may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.107 of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold the information you marked under section 552.107. You must release the remaining information.
