The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 955571.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the information you marked under section 552.108(a)(1) of the Government Code and section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with the common-law informer's privilege may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to those sections. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold the information you marked under section 552.108(a)(1) and section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with the common-law informer's privilege.
