Re: Request for information pertaining to specified charges against a named individual

Dear Ms. Bell:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 959073.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. Initially, we note the information we indicated is not responsive to the instant request because it does not pertain to the specified arrest. This ruling does not address the public availability of any information that is not responsive to the request, and you are not required to release such information in response to this request. You claim some of the responsive information must be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code. We agree you must withhold the marked motor vehicle record information in accordance with section 552.130 of the Government Code. Lastly, you must withhold the marked date(s) of birth pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with common-law privacy. *Paxton v. City of Dallas*, No. 03-13-00546-CV, 2015 WL 3394061, at *3 (Tex. App.—Austin May 22, 2015, pet. denied) (mem. op.).
