The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 964329 (Ref. No. 206220).

You state you do not have information responsive to a portion of the request.¹ After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.104 of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold the submitted information under section 552.104.
