Re: Request for records and video regarding case 102785 for an incident on 12/31/21.

Dear Mr. Tatsch:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 965494.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You state you have released some information to the requestor. Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you must withhold the submitted body worn camera recordings pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 1701.661(f) of the Occupations Code. You claim the remaining video recordings must be withheld from the requestor in their entirety pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code because you lack the technological capability to redact the motor vehicle record information not pertaining to the requestor from the recording. Thus, we agree you must withhold the remaining video recordings pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code.
