The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 971071.

Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you must withhold the submitted information pursuant to section 552.101 of the Government Code in conjunction with section 58.008(b) of the Family Code.
