The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 970465.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You claim the submitted representative sample of information may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.107 of the Government Code.<sup>1</sup> Upon review of your arguments and the submitted information, we conclude you may withhold the submitted information under section 552.107.
