Dear Ms. Villafuerte:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 977086 (PIA# 0165).

The Uvalde Consolidated Independent School District (the "district"), which you represent, received a request for a specified memorandum of understanding. You claim the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under sections 552.103 and 552.108 of the Government Code. We have considered the exceptions you claim and reviewed the submitted information.

We note the submitted information was the subject of a previous request for information, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2022-27745 (2022). In Open Records Letter No. 2022-27745, we determined the district must release the information at issue. We have no indication the law, facts, or circumstances on which the prior ruling was based have changed. Accordingly, we conclude the district must continue to rely on Open Records Letter No. 2022-27745 as a previous determination and release the information in accordance with this ruling.¹ See Open Records Decision No. 673 at 6-7 (2001) (discussing criteria for first type of previous determination).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

¹ As we are able to make this determination, we need not address your arguments against disclosure of the submitted information.
