Dear Ms. Ramos:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 981478.

The Uvalde County Sheriff's Office (the "sheriff's office") received a request for information pertaining to a specified incident. You claim the requested information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.108 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception you claim.

You inform us the requested information was the subject of a previous request for information, in response to which this office issued Open Records Letter No. 2022-26237 (2022). We have no indication the law, facts, or circumstances on which the prior ruling was based have changed. Accordingly, the sheriff's office must continue to rely on Open Records Letter No. 2022-26237 as a previous determination and withhold the requested information in accordance with that ruling.¹ See Open Records Decision No. 673 at 6-7 (2001) (discussing criteria for first type of previous determination).

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.

This ruling triggers important deadlines regarding the rights and responsibilities of the governmental body and of the requestor. For more information concerning those rights and
