Dear Ms. Bradley:

You ask whether certain information is subject to required public disclosure under the Public Information Act (the "Act"), chapter 552 of the Government Code. Your request was assigned ID# 984191 (ORR# PD-543-2022).

The City of Rosenberg (the "city") received a request for invoices from veterinarians who performed euthanasia for the city's animal shelter during a specified time period. The city claims the submitted information is excepted from disclosure under section 552.1177 of the Government Code. We have considered the exception the city claims and reviewed the submitted information.

Section 552.1177(a) of the Government Code relates to the humane disposition by a municipality or county of an animal and provides the following:

Except as provided by Subsection (b), information is confidential and excepted from [required public disclosure] if the information relates to the name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, driver's license number, social security number, or other personally identifying information of a person who obtains ownership or control of an animal from a municipality or county making a humane disposition of the animal under a municipal ordinance or an order of the commissioners court.

Gov't Code § 552.1177(a). Upon review, we find the city has failed to demonstrate any portion of the submitted information identifies a person who adopted an animal from the city's municipal animal shelter. Thus, the submitted information is not confidential under section 552.1177, and the city may not withhold it on that ground. The city must release the submitted information.

This letter ruling is limited to the particular information at issue in this request and limited to the facts as presented to us; therefore, this ruling must not be relied upon as a previous determination regarding any other information or any other circumstances.
