The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 987911 (Ref. No. R001760-091922).

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. You state you have released basic information pursuant to section 552.108(c) of the Government Code and claim the information you marked may be withheld from the requestor pursuant to section 552.108(a)(2) of the Government Code. Upon review of your arguments and the information at issue, we conclude you may withhold the marked information under section 552.108(a)(2).¹ The remaining information must be released.²

¹ As our ruling is dispositive, we need not address your remaining arguments against disclosure of this information.

² We note the requestor has a right of access to some of the information being released. *See* Gov't Code § 552.023(a) (governmental body may not deny access to person to whom information relates or person's agent on ground that information is considered confidential by privacy principles); Open Records Decision No. 481 at 4 (1987) (privacy theories not implicated when individuals request information concerning themselves). Thus, if you receive another request for the same information from a different requestor, you must again seek a decision from this office.
