Dear Ms. Davis:

The Office of the Attorney General has received your request for a ruling and assigned your request ID# 990176.

After reviewing your arguments and the submitted information, we have determined your request does not present a novel or complex issue. Thus, we are addressing your claims in a memorandum opinion. Initially, we note you only submitted body worn video recordings. To the extent any additional responsive information existed on the date you received the request, we assume you have released it. You claim the video recordings you indicated must be withheld from the requestor in their entirety pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code because you lack the technological capability to redact the motor vehicle record information not pertaining to the requestor's clients from the recordings. Thus, we agree you must withhold the video recordings you indicated pursuant to section 552.130 of the Government Code. The requestor does not give the requisite information under section 1701.661(a) of the Occupations Code for the remaining body worn camera recording. As the requestor did not properly request the body worn camera recording at issue pursuant to chapter 1701, our ruling does not reach this information and it need not be released.
