Dear General Paxton:

Pursuant to Texas Government Code § 402.042, I respectfully request an Attorney General Opinion with respect to the following questions:

May a local government home rule city enter into a contract with a Special Utility District that has the effect of prohibiting the city from petitioning for decertification of all or part of the Special Utility District's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in the future?

Do the self-rule provisions found in Texas Local Government Code Sections 51.072 and 51.078, and Article 11, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution allow a city to enter into such a contract and be bound by it?
